

ARCHITECTURAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR LEVEL DIGITAL WALLCOVERINGS WINDOW FILM

PART 1: GENERAL

1.1 Summary:

Contractor shall furnish, install and finish Level Digital Wallcoverings Window Film as specified in the contract documents.

1.2 Submittals:

For each type of Level Digital Wallcoverings Window Film material specified, the Contractor shall submit:

For Architect's approval, a sample, labeled with the appropriate material name and SKU information.

For Owner's approval, a copy of the maintenance instructions, as provided by Level Digital Wallcoverings.

1.3 Delivery and Storage:

All Level Digital Wallcoverings Window Film must be delivered to the job site in original packaging, properly identified and labeled.

Material must be stored in an undamaged condition in original packaging, maintained in a clean, dry, protected area where temperature and humidity remains stable and within the acceptable ranges for commercial wallcoverings.

All Level Digital Wallcoverings Window Film is to be inspected to verify that the delivered product is correct and that the color is accurate to what was ordered. Please see Section 3.2 for further details.

1.4 Project Conditions:

Environmental Conditions: Areas to receive Level Digital Wallcoverings Window Film should be environmentally controlled by the permanent HVAC system. Maintain a temperature range of 65 to 85 degrees Fahrenheit, with not more than 50% relative humidity and not less than what is specified for your area in the AWI Quality Standards Section 1700-T-19, for a period of not less than 4 days prior to installation and maintained thereafter.

Window/Glass Conditions: Windows & glass panels should be clean and free of any dirt particles. See Manufacturer's Installation Instructions for additional details.

Lighting: The Contractor will provide sufficient lighting during the installation process. If required, temporary lighting will be provided to augment insufficient or low level permanent lighting.

2.3 Physical Properties:

Physical properties vary based on the selected material. Full specifications for all materials may be downloaded at www.findyourlevel.com.

2.4 Warranty:

Warranties for *material only* vary based on the selected material. Contact Level Digital Wallcoverings to request the original manufacturer's warranties for each *material only*.

Level Digital Wallcoverings warrants its *finished product* to be free of defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year from date that finished product is received, and will replace any material found to be defective. Please inspect all Level Digital Wallcoverings goods immediately upon receipt. See Section 3.2 for details.

Level Digital Wallcoverings is not responsible for labor charges, improper installation, installation of incorrect goods (those not approved or confirmed by the customer), removal of goods, or problems arising from defects in the construction, surface, or preparation of the wall.

Level Digital Wallcoverings normally retains all job files for a period of three to five years from date of origin. Printed goods (including strike-off standards) older than one year will be discarded.

PART 3: EXECUTION

3.1 Level Digital Wallcoverings Window Film Shall be Applied by:

Window Film installers having a minimum of three years experience, on projects of similar size and complexity to this project, installing Window Film and/or the following:

3.2 Inspection:

The Installer shall inspect all jobsite conditions and wall surface areas to receive Level Digital Wallcoverings Window Film. In the event that the Installer finds conditions detrimental to the installation process, the Installer will inform the Contractor and the Architect in writing. Work will not proceed until conditions have been corrected and accepted by the Installer, and at no additional cost to Owner.

Additionally, upon receipt Installer is to inspect all Level Digital Wallcoverings Window Film to verify:

That the correct product was delivered

That the color, scale, and design are accurate to what was ordered

That the dimensions of the product correspond to those of the installation space

That the product is free from defects

That the alignment of the pattern across panels is correct

3.3 Surface Preparation:

Window surfaces shall be clean, smooth and free from defects and imperfections as per Level Digital Wallcovering's installation instructions.

3.4 Installation:

This is a custom made product and therefore its installation requires a higher attention to detail than installation of standard window film.

Custom window film is shipped with unprinted selvage around all edges that requires trimming during installation.

Level Digital Wallcoverings will furnish detailed installation instructions and an installation diagram to the Installer. The installation instructions describe the process for applying the window film and the installation diagram illustrates the appropriate sequence of panel installation. Level Digital Wallcoverings is not responsible for improper installation or for installation that deviates from the recommendations provided in these installation documents.

Prior to installation, the installer shall lay out all of the panels in their correct sequence, using the included installation diagram as reference. This setup shall be used to determine the best starting point and help detect any problems that may arise during installation. The installer shall make sure that the window film will properly fit the installation area before beginning pasting.

Level Digital Wallcoverings Window Film shall be installed in strict accordance with the installation instructions and installation diagram included with the finished goods. Install each panel in sequential, numerical order as specified by Level Digital Wallcoverings in the installation diagram included with the finished goods.

If either the installation instructions or installation diagram are missing from the finished goods, stop and contact Level Digital Wallcoverings immediately to receive replacement documents.

Overage is added to each job to allow for double-cutting the seams between panels and to allow for trimming around the normal irregularities found at window edges.

All Level Digital Wallcoverings products will be produced accurately to the dimensions provided. Level Digital Wallcoverings will not be responsible for any variations between the dimensions provided and those of the actual installation site.

3.5 Clean Up and Protection:

Upon completion of installation, Installer will remove excess materials from the premises and leave the area in a clean and orderly condition.

Contractor will protect the finished wallcovering from damage that may occur from other trades until project has been completed.

3.6 Maintenance:

Please see the installation instructions that are included with the finished goods.
