Care & Cleaning Guide: Real Wood Veneer

Before You Begin

Do not use abrasive cleaners containing chlorine bleach, solvents, or ammonia, as they may damage the surface and alter the integrity of the printed design.

WARNING: Never mix cleaning agents together, volatile reactions may occur!

Proper Care

Treat real wood veneer as you would fine furniture. Use a lint-free cloth and Murphy's Oil Soap to clean. This procedure must be done once a year using Murphy's recommended instructions.

Dust regularly with a slightly damp, soft, lint-free cloth.

Wipe dry with a soft cloth in the direction of the wood grain.

Spills should be immediately wiped up with a soft damp cloth.
